RULES and INFORMATION:

Approved helmets are required and all USAC rules will apply. USAC and Norba licenses will be accepted. USAC annual licenses can be purchased at the race site.

There is no pre-registration. On site registration opens at 9:00am and closes 15 min. before each race start.

Signed waivers are required before the start of the race. All junior participants must have waivers signed by the parent or guardian only. Family friends may not sign for juniors 17 and under.

One day licenses will be available for Cat 4 men and women (only) for \$10.00 in addition to the race entry fees.

The promoter reserves the right to split and combine fields as field sizes warrant.

Mountain bikes must have bar ends must be removed for these mass start events.

For detailed Points distribution information please see the website. Series Points will be awarded for each race with double points possible at each race with the flip of a coin.

\$499 in Cash and Merchandise prizes will be distributed at the final race of the series.
